We love having visitors for lunch. To best serve our students and the Kahla learning community, please be aware of and follow the guidelines listed below for lunch visitors.

- The **following dates are designated as no lunch visitor days** at Kahla MS. These dates are set to allow us time for setting up and managing routines, transitioning back after holidays, ending the year, and holding special events taking place that week. Please note additional days may be added and will be communicated via School Messenger.
 - August 26 – September 30; December 2-6, 2019; December 16-20, 2019; January 6-17, 2020; March 16-20, 2020; May 11-29, 2020
- Lunch visitors are welcome on Tuesdays and Thursdays **ONLY**.
- Please limit lunch visitors to **Guardians Only**.
 - Due to the size of our cafeteria, fire safety guidelines we must meet, and the amount of parent tables we have, this is needed so we can accommodate those who are coming for lunch.
 - If you're bringing children younger than 3, they will need to sit on your lap during lunch times for all children's safety.
 - School-aged children from other grade levels are not allowed at lunches since they should be in school. If they are home ill, they should be kept at home to keep other children well.
 - Please no strollers due to our limited space.
- If you are coming for lunch, it is important you are on time.
 - Lunch periods are only 30 minutes.
 - Arriving late for lunch means you may not be able to join your child.
- No lunch drop-offs.
 - In order to maintain a safe environment for our children to study and learn, we will not be able to accept lunch deliveries.
 - As a reminder, we do not accept deliveries, including flowers, balloons, stuffed animals or other gifts from other establishments or third-party delivery services.
 - You may bring lunch for your child if you are coming to eat with them.
- No videoing or photos in the cafeteria at lunch
 - Due to confidentiality guidelines that protect all our students, we ask that you not take videos or photos of students while at lunch in the cafeteria.
